

Reproduction Conditions

1. In all cases applications to reproduce works from the gallery collection must be made on the appropriate form to Christchurch Art Gallery Te Puna o Waiwhetu.
2. The Gallery reserves the right to decline any applications.
3. Notification by the publisher is required of any subsequent reprinting, new editions and other language editions of any works in advance of their publication. In some cases, new applications may be required for such further reprinting or editions and further fees may be charged.
4. For printed items, the permitted size of any print run will be confirmed in writing. For internet use, the duration of the licence will normally be five years.
5. The Gallery reserves the right to limit the number of reproductions of Gallery owned works of art if it appears that the number of such reproductions is disproportionate to those from other sources.
6. Full documentation and ownership credit, as specified by the Gallery, must appear either directly under the reproduction, on the facing page or on the reverse. Full documentation consists of the artists name, title of work of art, date, medium and size. In addition to the words 'Collection: Christchurch Art Gallery Te Puna o Waiwhetu' the credit line must include the donor's name when specified.
7. In the case of books with reproductions bound within the text, if the Gallery's reproductions would be the only ones giving the above information in one of the above stated locations, then only the artists name, title of work and date may be listed. However, the full documentation and ownership credit must appear elsewhere within the book, such as in an index or list of illustrations.
8. The reproduction must be full-tone black and white or full colour and may not be reproduced on colour stock. Nothing may be superimposed on the reproduction (i.e. lettering or tone or another image).
9. Unless specific consent otherwise is given, each work must be reproduced in its entirety and the reproduction may not be bled off the page or cropped in any way.
10. The Gallery assumes no responsibility for any royalties or fees claimed by the artist or on his/her behalf.
11. Obtaining copyright permission prior to reproducing the work/s, is the responsibility of the applicant. Reproductions can only be provided once the Gallery has received the written permission of the copyright holder.
12. The publisher must provide the Library of the Christchurch Art Gallery Te Puna o Waiwhetu with two copies of the item, regardless of its format, in which the reproduction appears.
13. Permission to reproduce any work is conditional on the payment of any fee levied.
