With a diverse range of skills between the three artists ranging from traditional graffiti styles, photorealism, psychedelic funk and everything in between. this mural promises to be one to watch out for.

Gaby Montejo Mothers Honeypot Café

6.30 Sharp - 458 Colombo St Gaby's creative practice is one where human relations often play an essential role. Meaning that a piece of art should have its origins in a sort-of friendly trust, and may even need people to trigger things happening. Making for a sculpture of the active kind, alive and real, Gaby Monteio is putting on an event not to be missed. This will NOT be a performance; it is more of a presentation or celebration of sorts.

Tape Art NZ Temporary Tape Art Mural Landley Law Building
