gardens complemented by contemporary sculpture.

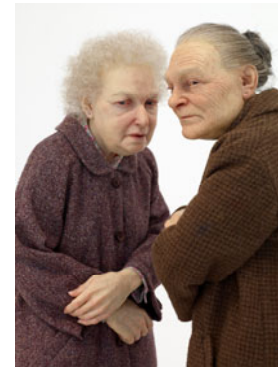
