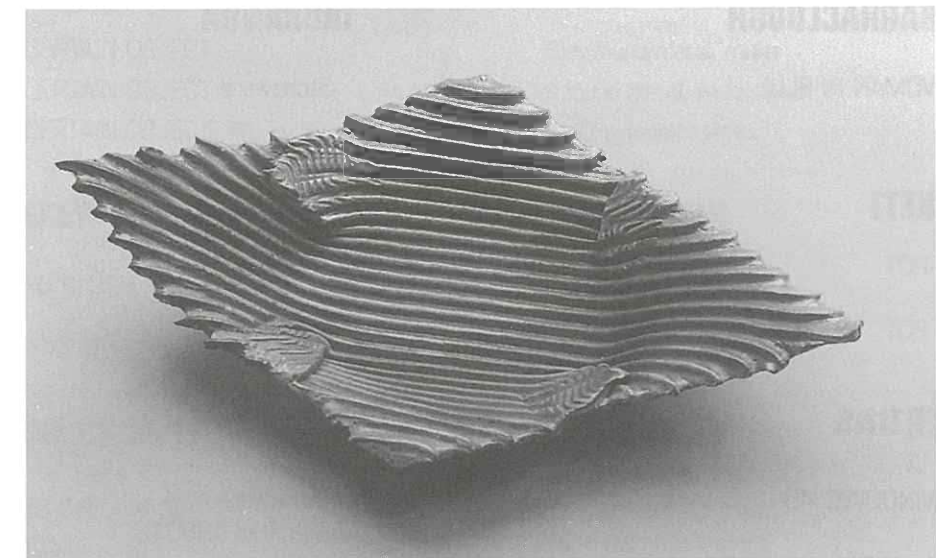
With this in mind, the brief we set ourselves was to select an exhibition which fairly represents the very best work from that submitted by the members of the New Zealand Society of Potters.
