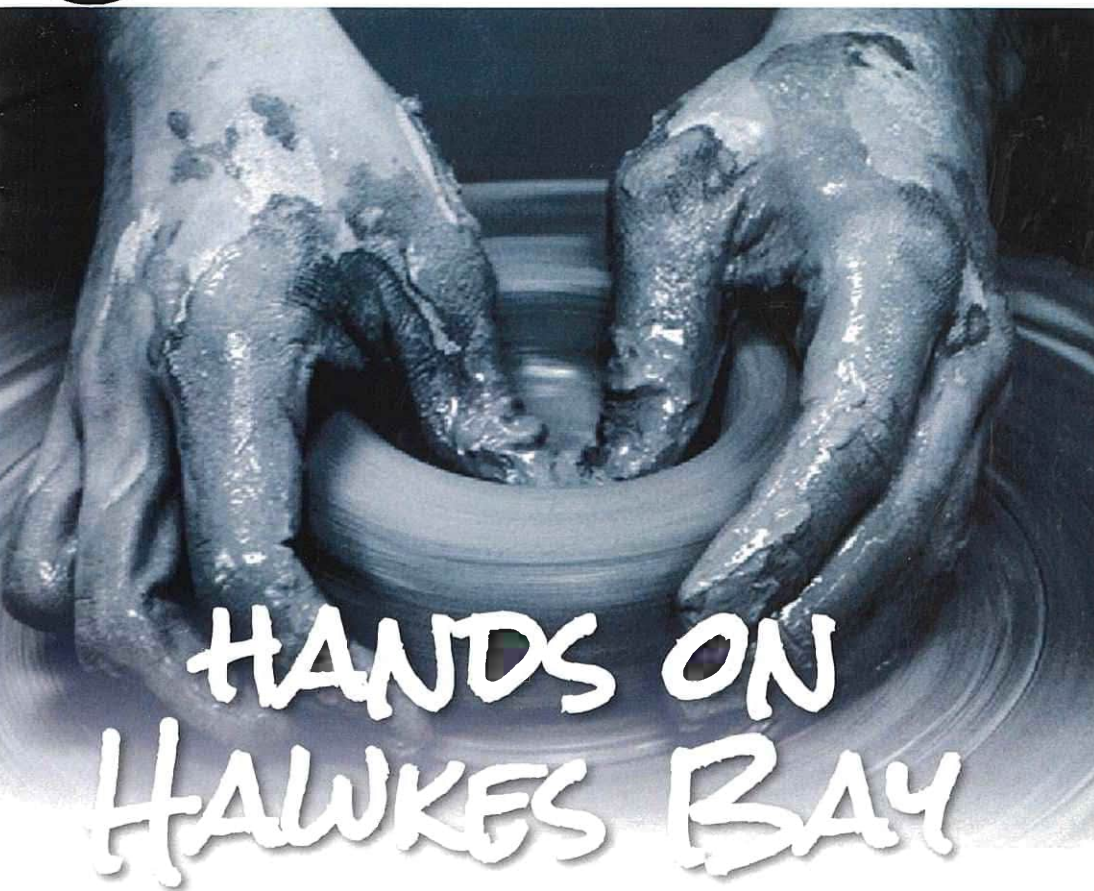

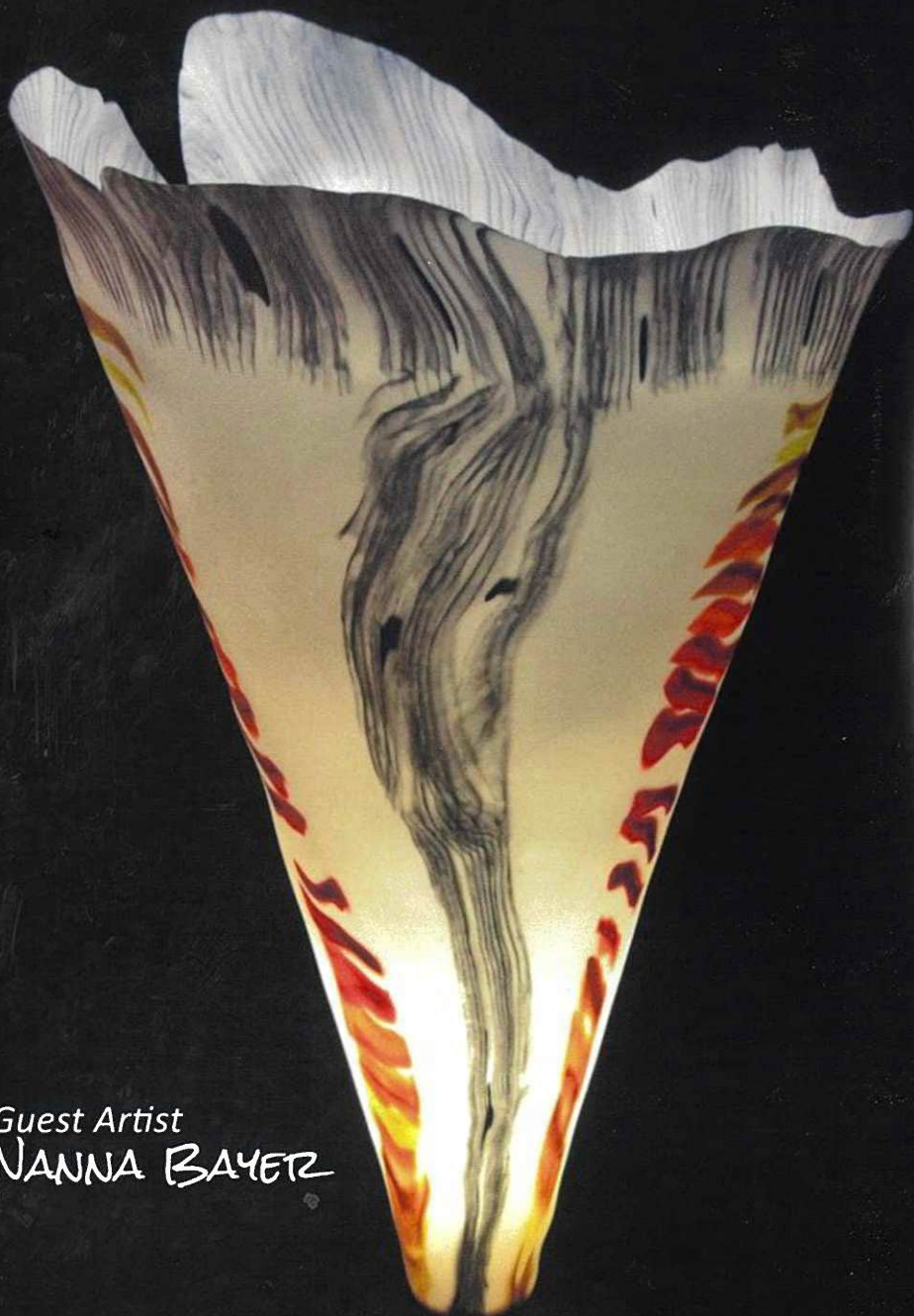

She is a member of the Finnish Association of Designers and Artisans, and the Designers and Artist of the Fiskars Co-operation.

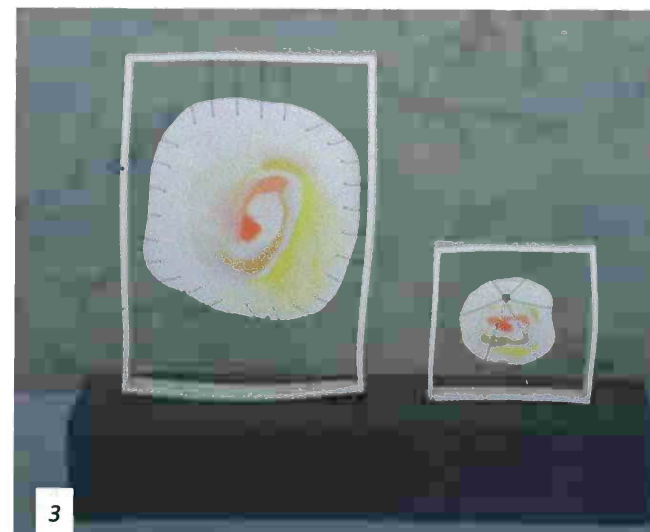
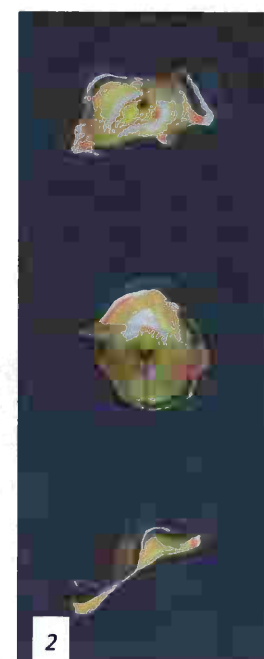
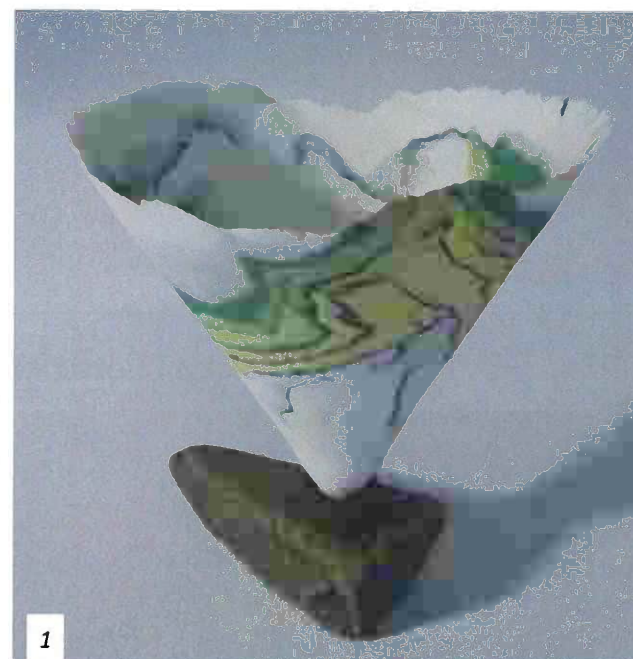
Nanna began her practice as a ceramic artist in the early 1990's. Since 2001 her studio has been based in the design village of Fiskars, Finland.
