



Nanna began her practice as a ceramic artist in the early 1990's. Since 2001 her studio has been based in the design village of Fiskars, Finland.

Nanna's art work is an extension on from the Scandinavian design ethos of the simple pure form by playfully adding richly coloured patterns to functional ceramic objects.

The extensions of the Finnish environment and her previous professions of tailor and furrier influence her work that is articulated by the lovely and sometimes humorous artistic expression.






