FOREWORD

The Sixth Annual Exhibition by New Zealand potters is something of a landmark, because for the first time the movement behind it is strong enough and sufficiently established for a stringent system of selection to be imposed. What is in this Exhibition is here because it is the best the individual potter has to offer, because it is the best in comparison with the work of other potters in the same field, and because it is good of its kind in the eyes of a panel who should know.

In this respect the bare statements of the catalogue which follow are misleading. They cannot evoke the quality of the articles themselves, their texture, form and balance, the thousand and one things that are distinctive of the work of art or of craft. Each denotation is, however, a warrant for the time, individuality and technique which at worst separate the hand-made artifact from the factory stereotype, and which at best effect the marriage of art and craft in what is aesthetically pleasing and usefully significant. All of them bear "the mark of the potter".

Something of the development of New Zealand pottery since the first Exhibition in 1957 is recorded in the files of **The New Zealand Potter**, where the great names of the potter's world, Bernard Leach of England and Shoji Hamada of Japan, pervade the printed page as examples of a living tradition which has still to be created here. What is in **this** Exhibition is a comment on their principles and practice, in the use of local rock, clay and ash, and in the stress they lay upon the artifact as an expression of thought and feeling: it is also evidence at least of the beginning of a living tradition, for here is variety within the New Zealand context, the sense of continuity with the past developed in the passionate experience of the individual: as Lee Thompson puts it —

*Oh, Potter, at your age old task
With reverence handles clay and wheel
The past is spinning in your hands
To marry with the urgent flame*
