WELLINGTON TECHNICAL SCHOOL.

As the study of Nature is of the first importance to artists, students attending the Wellington Technical School are offered continuous facilities for the study of natural form and colour. The Life Model, male or female, is posed each day for the head or figure, for drawing, painting or modelling. As sound and searching drawing can only be obtained by a thorough knowledge of the construction of the human figure, special classes are held to instruct students in the forms which affect the surface. At times arrangements are made so that students may make studies of action in the human figure, such studies being of considerable value as records for later use. The study of animals, a class for which is held regularly, also provides students with an extensive and varied collection of drawings for future reference, as well as affording a means of cultivating the habit of memorising and quick sketching, which is of the utmost value to artists. A class for the study of landscape, trees, and other out of door subjects in black and white and colour is held regularly, providing students with an introduction to the art of landscape painting. Classes are also held for the study of plants, flowers, still life, and natural forms generally.

Sculptors and modellers are provided for by a number of classes held both during the day and evening. The male or female model is posed for students wishing to study from the human figure, and animals, plants and other objects are provided according to the needs of the students. A large collection of casts of works of merit is also available for study.

Designers and art craftsmen are instructed in their various subjects and facilities are available for the complete execution of designs in several crafts, as jewellery, metalwork and enamelling; woodcarving; plasterwork; embroidery; stained and painted glass; stone and marble carving; stencilling; lettering, writing and illuminating, leather embossing.

The classes are held from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 4.30 p.m., and in the evening from 7 to 9.30 p.m.


